

# Standard equipment



**Version: 5 cabins, fixed keel**

**Draft: 2,30 m**

## Hull

- White gelcoat
- GRP hand lay-up with anti-osmosis barrier, sandwich construction
- Dark blue water line stripes
- Ballast in cast iron
- Galvanized steel hull liner connects keel with chain plates
- Pre-balanced rudder
- 6 portholes

## Deck

- White gelcoat
- GRP hand lay-up, sandwich construction
- Anti-slip surface
- Anchor holder
- Anchor hatch with extra reinforcement for windlass
- Windlass (under the deck)
- Pulpit
- 2 pushpits
- 2 handrails
- Aluminum toe-rail with ten open chocks
- 6 mooring cleats: 2 forward, 2 central, 2 aft
- 8 stanchions with double lifelines
- Opening gates in lifelines
- 2 big hatches (forward cabin, saloon), with ventilation
- 10 small hatches
- 3 skylights in deck (saloon)
- 2 side skylights
- Self-tacking jib track with car
- Main sheet track with car
- 12 deck organizers
- 16 rope clutches
- 2 self-tailing winches 45
- Navigation LED lights
- Aft shower for hot and cold water

## Cockpit

- Self-draining cockpit with four lockers
- Gas bottles locker
- Teak laid seats
- Teak laid cockpit floor
- Sliding hatch and wooden doors with hinges and lock
- 2 handrails
- Hatch in each aft cabin
- 2 steering pedestals with handrails and wheels covered with leather
- Teak table
- Engine control panel
- Emergency tiller
- 2 self-tailing winches 50
- Stern ladder
- Swim platform teak laid

## Rig, sails

- Mast in two parts with standing rigging, on keel step, backstay with rigging screw
- Boom (single line reef) and rod/dick with gas spring
- Half battened mainsail with two reefs
- "German sheeting"
- Lazy Bag + Lazy Jack – colour MARINE BLUE

- Self-tacking, furling jib
- Set of halyards and sheets
- 2 winch handles (long + short)
- Anchor light, steaming light and deck spotlight

## Cabins, toilets

- All joinery work in beech plywood, slight difference of hue is possible, matt varnish
- HPL plywood floor in single color
- Upholstery (white/bedsheet cover material in cabins, saloon according to NORDIC BASIC collection)
- Boards lined with panels
- 3 forward cabins with wardrobes and double level berths
- 2 forward toilet cabins made of laminate with manual toilets and holding tanks 47 L each
- 2 aft cabins with double berths, wardrobes and shelves
- 2 aft toilet cabins made of laminate with manual toilets and holding tanks 47 L each

## Saloon, galley

- Shelves and lockers on both sides of saloon
- Navigation table
- Table with L-shaped sofa and two seats
- Double stainless steel sink with covers
- Tap for hot and cold water
- Twin burner gimbaled cooker with oven
- Fridge 160 L, double drawer
- HPL work surface in dark colour
- Lockers and shelves in galley
- Fire extinguishers and fire blanket
- Waste basket

## Electrical installation

- Interior LED lighting
- Master electric switch panel, indicator of battery voltage, level gauges for water, waste water and diesel tank
- Main electrical switches
- 2 x 12V sockets (navigation table, steering pedestal)
- 230 V sockets (cabins, navigation table, galley)
- House batteries AGM 3 x 110 Ah
- Starting battery AGM 110 Ah
- Battery charger 230V/12V/40A with 25 m cable

## Water installation

- Water pressure system with hot and cold water
- Drinking water tanks, capacity 490 L; boiler 40 L
- Outboard water pump
- 2 electric bilge pumps
- 1 manual bilge pump

## Gas installation

- Gas installation
- Installation tightness tester

## Engine

- Engine Volvo Penta D2-60 (60 HP) with S-drive
- Fixed 2-blade propeller
- Fuel tank 235 L

## Navigational instruments

- 2 magnetic compasses
- B&G Triton, Speed/Depth/Temperature (mounted on starboard side steering pedestal)

## Others

- Foil wrapping
- Loading on truck
